What's New

With the 2.0 release, SDM Software introduces several key enhancements to provide operational change control across Group Policy and Intune from a single interface. These updates eliminate the need to switch between management consoles and ensure all changes follow your established, secure processes.

With Change Manager for Group Policy/Intune (CMGPI) 2.0, now you can:

- **Centralize Intune management.** Create new Intune profiles directly within the CMGPI interface using the new Intune Profile Creator role. This eliminates the need to jump between different configuration consoles to perform routine tasks.
- **Secure your environment.** Detect GPO tampering and malicious attacks in real time with proactive monitoring. CMGPI alerts you to out-of-band or malicious changes as they happen. Even stealthy attacks that attempt to inject changes directly into the SYSVOL part of a GPO will be detected.
- **Recover faster** with a new global role for restoring deleted GPOs.
- **Simplify analysis and reporting** with 22 in-the-box reports across GPO, AD Containers, and Intune.
- **Organize configurations** with tagging GPOs. This streamlines navigation and makes it easier to track settings related to specific regulatory compliance standards.

Additional features for an even smoother experience for IT administrators:

- Email notifications are cached if the system is offline and sent once service is restored.
- Logon and logoff auditing.
- Audit logs now include the IP address of the user who performed each operation for improved accountability.
- GPO filtering is now available when linking or unlinking options on containers, making complex deployments more manageable.
